

CONTINUING FORMATION FOR LITURGICAL MINISTERS

For Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Lectors and Ushers

The Liturgy Office will send faculty throughout the diocese for the continuing formation of current ministers: Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Lectors and Ushers. This additional formation does not replace the current Liturgical Ministers' Training that is in effect for those beginning a liturgical ministry within the diocese. It is designed to enhance the understanding and appreciation of each individual who currently exercises a ministry within the diocese and to help pastors and parish staffs address various liturgical concerns.

The sessions will be held on the local level for a parish, cluster or school and will cover two and one half (2 ½) hours of instruction time. There is a specific session proper to each ministry: Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Lectors and Ushers. They are not intended for general liturgical or theological formation but for the specific ministry requested. Please do not place individuals in groups outside of their proper ministry.

Aspects covered in the presentations:

- An Overview and Encouragement in Liturgical Ministry
- Concerns of Pastor(s)/Parish Staff(s)/Campus Ministers
- The General Instruction of the Roman Missal
- Questions

The faculty member assigned to present will ask the inviting contact person if there are any specific concerns that should be addressed in the session.

The program is available in both English and Spanish languages.

The cost is \$20 per person enrolled. There is a minimum of 20 people needed for each session to take place.

Should the sponsoring entity wish to provide breakfast/lunch/dinner or coffee/snack it is its responsibility to do so. Food is not provided by the Liturgy Office for this Continuing Formation Program as is the custom at the Liturgical Ministers' Training Workshops.

To schedule a session, three dates and times must be submitted for each ministry and language group at least two months in advance to allow faculty recruitment and proper notification of the ministers involved on the local level. Registration materials are included in this packet.
