Lay Ministry Program Overview

I. Initial Stage (Two Years) – All Participants

First Semester

- Orientation and Theological Conference (12 hours)
- Theology of Lay Ministry (8 hours)
- Ecclesiology (16 hours)
- Spiritual Formation Day

Online required courses: Creed (10 hours) and Revelation of God (10 hours)

Third Semester

- Liturgy and Sacraments (16 hours)
- Ecumenical/Interreligious Dialogue (6 hours)
- Spiritual Formation Day (6 hours)

Second Semester

- Old Testament (14 hours)
- New Testament (14 hours)
- Spiritual Formation Day (6 hours)

Fourth Semester

- Christology (14 hours)
- Moral Theology (14 hours)
- Information Session for Second Stage (3 hours)
- Spiritual Formation Day (6 hours)

Online elective courses: Church History (5 hours) and Catholic Social Teachings (5 hours)

At the end of the Initial Stage, participants will make one of the following elections:

- 1. End participation and receive a certificate of completion for the courses that were taken.
- 2. Continue to Second Stage in one of the four tracks.

II. Second Stage

1. Volunteer Lay Pastoral Leader Track (includes bereavement, pastoral care of the sick and homebound, consolation, social justice, liturgical ministry, etc.) – Conducted by Pastoral Institute – Timeframe: One Year

Fifth Semester

- Ministry Practicum Begins
- Ministry Seminar (6-10 hours)
- Pastoral Skills Workshops:
 - Leadership as Service (6 hours)
 - Creating Prayer and Ritual (6 hours)
 - Creating Communion in a Culturally Diverse Faith Community (6 hours)
- Spiritual Formation Day (6 hours)

Sixth Semester

- Ministry Practicum Concludes
- Canon Law Issues for Parish Ministers Seminar (4 hours)
- Pastoral Skills Workshops:
 - o Communication Skills (6 hours)
 - Self-Care of the Pastoral Minister (6 hours)
 - o Organizational Leadership (6 hours)
- Spiritual Formation Day (6 hours)

2. Catechetical Leader Track (includes Parish Catechetical Leader, Youth Ministry, Young Adult Ministry, RCIA, Adult Faith Formation, Sacramental Preparation, Family Life/Respect Life, Special Needs) – Coordinated by Office of Faith Formation

Diocesan Program (LLF Catechetical Leader Professional Development) \underline{OR} M.A. in Theology \underline{OR} M.A. in Religious Education \underline{OR} M.A. in Religious Education: Youth and Young Adult Ministry

3. Other Tracks of Study – Coordinated by Pastoral Institute
