

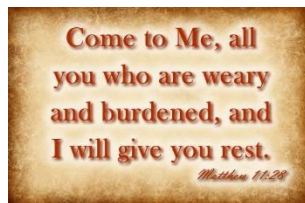
Confraternity of Survivors:
