As OCIA leaders, we often encounter participants who find Catholic teachings about Mary challenging. **Here's how we can help them embrace the Mother of God:**

Through Christ-Centered Formation:

• Root all Marian teaching in Jesus' gift of His mother from the cross

- Show how authentic Marian devotion naturally flows from understanding Christ
- Connect Mary's role to the fundamental truths about Jesus as Lord, Savior, and Second Person of the Trinity

Practical Teaching Approaches:

- Provide clear catechesis on Marian doctrines
- Introduce the Rosary as a Christ-centered prayer
- Share stories of Marian apparitions to illustrate her ongoing maternal care
- Address common objections with patience and understanding

When participants struggle with Marian devotion, we can offer this simple but profound suggestion: **"Ask Jesus what He wants you to do about His Mom."** This invitation often opens hearts to seeing Mary through Jesus' eyes.

May Our Lady of Lourdes guide your ministry and wrap each of your catechumens in her maternal care.
